

Human resources is the largest and most valuable asset of the Hospital. Our priority is fostering a culture of collaboration, ongoing training and development.



Ambulances are on call for 24 hours and a helipad is located just 200 meters away from the building

The Hospital has been equipped with the latest technology diagnostic devices so that physicians may seamlessly provide superior quality services to patients. All the radiological equipment is licensed by the Greek Atomic Energy Commission.









A number of precautionary measures are being implemented in Chania General Hospital by the new corona, which aim at the safety of all of us.

- Infections Committee that implements all the necessary protective measures in order to ensure the safety of patients, visitors and others. and the employees of the Group.
- All departments and clinics of the Hospital operate in accordance with the instructions of the Ministry of Health and EODY.
- Controlled entrance is performed only from one point in the Hospital so that all
 visitors and patients are checked. Entrants are asked special questions by
 HYGEIA security personnel. All those who come to the Hospital (patients, visitors
 and staff), necessarily wear a mask and are thermometered at the entrance.
- In order to avoid congestion in the waiting areas,
 - All appointments are scheduled with a time difference between them
 - Special layout in all areas to keep the social distance mandatory.
 - Between examinations, there is a longer period of time for the space to be adequately ventilated and thoroughly cleaned
 - All areas of the hospital are constantly monitored to ensure that hygiene and safety rules are followed.
 - > All the apointments are scheduled throught the telephone
- Special labels and instructions have been placed on several points to inform visitors and patients.

- To avoid congestion, limited number of people are allowed to enter the elevator areas. These are thoroughly cleaned on a daily basis at regular intervals.
- Suspected cases or patients with symptoms are examined in specially designed areas outside the hospital to determine if they are COVID-19 patients. Three examinations rooms have been set up in an external area of the main building that operate with security protocols (There are 8 separate waiting rooms for them).
- Security protocols and action plans have been developed to deal with confirmed COVID-19 or suspected with COVID -19 patients. Readiness exercises were performed.
- Two special COVID-19 clinics were developed: An intermediate COVID-19 clinic
 with 11 rooms and 34 beds for the reception of suspected with COVID -19
 patients for max 24 hours and a COVID-19 Clinic with 11 rooms and 36 beds for
 the hospitalization of confirmed COVID-19 patients.
- The Intensive Unit beds are increased to 15 while 5 Intensive unit Beds were kept only for Covid -19 patients.
