You will need to book an appointment with a solicitor, a Commissioner for oath officer or a notary officer to apply for this declaration. The declaration must be dated within 3 months of your marriage date. An example of what must be included is shown below:

SENDING YOUR DOCUMENTS

When you have all of your completed documents, you'll need to scan both sides of each documents and the photo page of both passports and send them to your wedding planner. You can also send them to weddings@mareresorts.com It's important that all your scanned documents are with us no later than 5 weeks before your wedding date. All original documents must be taken to resort with you and handed to your wedding planner. Without these documents we will be unable to proceed with a legal ceremony.
